

School District Food Offerings during Closure:

Belle Vernon –

Offering Grab and Go meals to any child between the ages of 2 and 18 beginning Monday, March 30, 2020. Both breakfast and lunch will be provided. You MUST sign up in order to receive these meals. Meals will be provided on WEEKDAYS.

Meals can be picked up at the following locations between 11am – 12pm: Marion Elementary School at 500 Perry Avenue, Belle Vernon OR Rostraver Elementary School at 300 Crest Avenue, Rostraver Township. Meals will be served outside of the main entrance of each building. Only 1 person should approach the serving table when accepting the meals, keeping a minimum of 6 feet of space between anyone else in line. The district will also provide delivery drop offs by school bus at the following locations: Marion Villa (in the circle) at 11am, Rostraver Apartments (at both bus stops) at 11:20am, and Port Royal Village (at both stops) at 11:45am.

Please note all the meals are free to any Derry Area School District student and any other person under the age of 18 who lives in the district. You do not have to be on free or reduced lunch to receive a meal. This is open to all.

The drive thru at the High School is being relocated to the AV Germano Hall (previously called Derry Community Center) on May 22, 2020. The time will still be 11am until 1pm. It is being relocated to accommodate the seniors who will be attending the Senior Farewell Luncheon.

Franklin Regional School District -

Leechburg Area School District –

1. Breakfast and lunches: We have decided that we will do bagged lunches with breakfast in the bags for the following morning. This meal service will start this Wednesday, March 18 and will last throughout the duration of the closure. Availability is 11am to 1pm Monday through Friday.

The following are the requirements to receive a meal:

A. Meals are available for anyone between the ages of 0-18. This week it will be Yo-to-Go as the lunch and Pop-tarts for the breakfast. Starting next week, we will be having peanut butter and jelly with the lunch essentials (fruit, milk, etc). No hot meals will be served.

B. The child(ren) has to be with an adult when getting the lunch. If a child is not present, a lunch will not be given.

C. A staff member will hand it directly to you from your car window outside of the cafeteria entrance. This is the same entrance as kids use every morning. No walk-ups are permitted.

D. If you cannot get to the school for lack of transportation, please email tnix@leechburg.k12.pa.us. Delivery will be made available.
